**Food Services Update:** Under a new waiver from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), **any child ages 1 - 18** can receive meals every day of the week under the National School Breakfast Program and National School Lunch Program **at no cost** through December

2020. There are no eligibility requirements to access this service. The Food Services Department has adjusted the Meal Distribution Schedule to allow for this new waiver.

Adults may still pick up meals for students without the student present. The adult will need to show a photo i.d. and identify the names of the children who will receive the meals.

The Food Services Department still recommends any family who qualifies for the Free or Reduced Price Meal Program (FRPM) submit the application for approval. This is important in accessing other benefits provided to qualifying families and will ensure a seamless transition once this waiver expires in January. **How to get an El Segundo Library Card for Your Child:** All students in ESUSD schools have access to a ESPL card. To get your student a library card at the El Segundo Public Library, please <a href="mailto:apply-online">apply online</a> and submit your current picture ID and proof of residence, via separate email to: circdesk@elsegundo.org.

They accept any of the following as photo identification: a valid driver's license, a valid California ID, or a US passport. For photo ID without a current address, you will need to provide one of the following: a current utility bill, a credit card statement, a rental property or tax receipt, current school documents that show your home address, or a car registration. Parents of returning students: if you haven't gotten it already, your child's library card is available to pick up at the El Segundo Public Library through its Library to Go curbside service. Please call 310-524-2722, from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, for more information.

El Segundo Public Library cards can be used to access digital resources including eBooks, online databases and more. You can also request physical materials for contactless pickup using our Library to Go curbside service. More details are on the ESPL website.

**Fall TLC Enrollment Application:** The Learning Connection (TLC) child care program is opening up its Fall 2020 Enrollment Application to elementary families who need child care. The child care program will begin on Tuesday, September 8, 2020 and the times will be 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday at a cost of \$1,200 a month per child. This is the only option being offered for child care this fall semester. Unfortunately we can not offer half days of care or partial weekday attendance. This application is open to families whether you chose the full distant learning model or in-person hybrid learning model. Fall Child Care participants can expect to be notified of acceptance and SmartCare billing within the next week.

We want to thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate how to best support our elementary school site families' needs in this coming school year. As our school situation changes so will the support that TLC offers for your child care needs.
