- 4th/5th Grade Playground Update:
  - Have to do an ADA buildout, but we're already ADA compliant throughout the school. So the playground must be accessible in a wheelchair. Shouldn't be hard,we just need a little more money. We need a path to get from a few areas to the playground. Must be direct access. The three companies that were approved for

equipment, will be contacted to see if they can build with ADA compliance in mind. Then we buy equipment and the company stores it. Once we have our funds, we get started on the building. (Equipment needs to be bought first, then we pay the builders.) Goal is to get this started after the JAT next year, so fall 2022. Ballparking the whole project may be close to \$200K now. Would love for it to be in by Jan of 2023, but we'll need some money from next year's JAT. Working on logistics and budgets, etc. Dr. M says as soon as everything is in place, it isn't a hard job, so it should just happen easily.
